On March 27, 2026, the Board granted 9,822,000 Share Options and 1,872,000 Share Awards in aggregate to employees and a service provider of the Group under the 2024 Share Scheme. Details of the aforementioned grants are as follows:

GRANT OF SHARE OPTIONS

The Board announces that on March 27, 2026, subject to the acceptance by the Grantees, the Company granted 9,822,000 Share Options (each entitling the holder thereof to subscribe for one (1) Class B Share) under the 2024 Share Scheme, representing approximately 2.61% of the total Class B Shares in issue (excluding any treasury shares) as at the date of grant. The Board announces that on March 27, 2026, subject to the acceptance by the Grantees, the Company granted 1,872,000 Share Awards (each entitling the holder thereof to subscribe for one (1) Class B Share) under the 2024 Share Scheme, representing approximately 0.50% of the total Class B Shares in issue (excluding any treasury shares) as at the date of grant. In respect of the Share Awards granted to employee participants of the Group, the period between the date of grant and the first vesting date is shorter than 12 months. The Remuneration Committee is of the view that such a shorter vesting period is appropriate and aligns with the 2024 Share Scheme Rules, as the grants are subject to (i) performance-based vesting conditions; and (ii) an overall vesting period exceeding 12 months, under which the Share Awards will vest in equal installments.

The vesting of the Share Awards shall be conditional upon the Grantee having satisfied specified performance targets in the most recent performance review conducted prior to the relevant vesting date. Such performance targets shall include the Grantee's individual appraisal results for the applicable vesting period. If the Grantee fails to attain the required grades in the performance review, all unvested Share Awards of the corresponding vesting period shall automatically lapse.

FURTHER INFORMATION ON THE OPTION GRANT AND THE AWARD GRANT UNDER THE 2024 SHARE SCHEME

Pursuant to Rule 17.04(1) of the Listing Rules, the Option Grant and Award Grant to Ms. Wang had been approved by the independent non-executive Directors. Ms. Wang had abstained from voting on the resolution relating to the Option Grant and Award Grant to herself and had not been counted towards the quorum of the Board meeting in respect of such resolution.

To the best of the Directors' knowledge, information and belief having made all reasonable enquiries, save as disclosed in this announcement, none of the Grantees is (i) a Director, or a chief executive, or a substantial shareholder, or an associate of any of them; (ii) a participant with options and awards granted and to be granted exceeding the 1% individual limit under Rule 17.03D of the Listing Rules; or (iii) a related entity participant or service provider with options and awards granted and to be granted in any 12-month period exceeding 0.1% of the total number of issued Shares (excluding any treasury shares). In addition, the Award Shares underlying the Share Awards granted to Ms. Wang in the 12-month period up to and including the date of grant is less than 0.1% of the total number of issued Shares (excluding any treasury shares). Hence, the Option Grant and Award Grant are not subject to approval by the Shareholders.

There are no arrangements for the Company or any of its subsidiaries to provide financial assistance to the Grantees to facilitate the purchase of Class B Shares under the 2024 Share Scheme.

REASONS FOR THE OPTION GRANT AND AWARD GRANT

The Board is of the view that the Option Grant and Award Grant enable the Company to use non-cash incentives to attract the Grantees, including service provider participant, to work towards enhancing the value and attaining the long-term objectives of the Group, whilst also aligning their interest with that of the Group and the Shareholders through the Grantees owning proprietary interest in the Company and becoming Shareholders, which is aligned with the purpose of the 2024 Share Scheme.

The service provider participant who was granted the Share Awards is a consultant engaged by the Group to provide strategic planning and business advisory services on a continuing and regular basis to the Group, with the continuity and frequency of his services being comparable to those of employees. The Board considers the provision of such advisory and/or consultancy services to be in the ordinary and usual course of business of the Group, and is of the view that such grant to the service provider participant will benefit the Group's long-term growth by incentivising him to contribute his expertise and support the Group's operations and future development. The Board further believes that such grant to the service provider participant is in the interest of the Company and the Shareholders as a whole and aligns with the purposes of the 2024 Share Scheme.

NUMBER OF CLASS B SHARES AVAILABLE FOR FUTURE GRANTS

The Option Grant and the Award Grant will be satisfied by issuance of new Class B Shares and/or transfer of Class B Shares in treasury within the Scheme Mandate Limit. As of the date of this announcement (after taking into account of the Option Grant and the Award Grant), 26,988,996 and 4,730,799 Class B Shares are available for future grant under the Scheme Mandate Limit and Service Provider Sublimit, respectively.
